This autumn the administrator of the CJTS and the secretary of The Breed Council, plan to get together and work on the early update of the Joint Breed Council / CJTS combined judging lists, so that the new lists are finalised for early January.

Please find the enclosed form to be completed telling us of the CHOW judging assignments you have undertaken.

The Kennel Club insists that you keep complete and accurate records, and it is in your interest to do so.

In the past we have been aware that some people are confused when stating the number of classes / dogs judged, and for this reason we ask that you **re-submit information of your past engagements**, so that both you and I have a precise record.

Please record your details as accurately as possible, for example do not include classes as being judged if there were no entries in that class, or there were entries but they were all absent. Likewise only count the number of dogs present as dogs being judged, see the example below, the column "Number of dogs Judged", when added to the column, "Number of dogs Absent", should total back to the "Number of dogs Entered"

For example, the recording of Melton Mowbray show, it was a 3 class show, there were 6 chows entered making 7 entries. 3 in Junior, 3 in Post Grad and 1 in Open. The one dog in Post Grad was a "seen" dog, this calculation gives 7 entries from just 6 dogs. On the day the single entry in Open class was absent,. So the total number of dogs judged were 5 in 2 classes.
